RESOLUTION

REPEALING RESOLUTION 54873, ADOPTED APRIL 8, 2020, AND REINSTATING TITLE 9 - LICENSING AND REGULATION OF TRADES AND OCCUPATIONS, CHAPTER 18 - WINE, BEER, AND LIQUOR, SECTION 9:1000, ET SEQ. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BATON ROUGE AND PARISH OF EAST BATON ROUGE, PERTAINING TO THE SALE OF AND REGULATION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2020, the Metropolitan Council adopted Resolution 54873 recognizing that a public health emergency exists and suspending Title 9 - Licensing and Regulation of Trades and Occupation, Chapter 18. - Wine, Beer and liquor, Section 9:1000, et seq. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge, pertaining to the sale and regulation of alcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS, the public health emergency continues to exist; however, businesses located in the Parish of East Baton Rouge and City of Baton Rouge which sell alcoholic beverages have resumed operation and it is in the best interest of the public to reinstate local ordinances so that the Office of Alcoholic Beverage Control for the Parish of East Baton Rouge and City of Baton Rouge be allowed to regulate the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Metropolitan Council of the Parish of East Baton Rouge and the City of Baton Rouge that:

Section 1. Resolution 54873, adopted on April 8, 2020, is hereby repealed in its entirety, thus reinstating Title 9 - Licensing and Regulation of Trades and Occupation, Chapter 18. - Wine, Beer and liquor, Section 9:1000, et seq. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton

Rouge, pertaining to the sale and regulation of alcoholic beverages.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective immediately following adoption by the Metropolitan Council.
